This information sheet provides an example of what a donor profile may look like for people considering donating sperm, eggs or embryos, and potential recipients.

Non-identifying details about the donor are used to create a donor profile. Potential recipients review the donor profile to see whether the donor is a match with what they are looking for. The following is an example of what a donor profile may look like.
